### **NOVENA & FEAST OF THE DIVINE MERCY**

The Novena of Divine Mercy is to start on Good Friday and continue for the nine days ending on Divine Mercy Weekend. It is a powerful Novena given to us by Jesus, Himself. Free framed images of Jesus, Divine Mercy are available in the Narthax at the back of the church, as well as Pamphlets with the Novena and Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Jesus told Sr. Faustina that He desires that the Feast of Divine Mercy be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. He said "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fountain of My mercy. I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy. Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted omplete forgiveness of sins and punishment."

The Novena and Chaplet of Divine Mercy can be said in less than 10 minutes and the graces obtained through these prayers are unimaginable. Although the Novena is to be said from Good Friday through Divine Mercy Sunday, it can be said daily with the Chaplet and is a great opportunity for the family to pray together for a brief time.
